English Year 2

Students will create, rehearse and present an informative text (in the form of a procedure) derived from an imaginative text that contains a procedure. Students read and comprehend an imaginative text and a procedural text and respond to literal and inferential questions.

HASS

Year 2— Students investigate how technology has resulted in changes to travel, communication, leisure time, school, home life and toys. They learn how to use timelines, pose questions, analyse photographs and compare past and present. They identify how areas of life, such as rules of the present day, have been impacted by technology.



Science

Exploring Growth

Students will describe and represent the changes to a living thing in its life stages. Students will compare the life stages of two different living things.

PE

Year 2—Students will participate in games and activities where they develop skills to control and kick large round balls and overarm throw small balls. They will learn to adjust the force and angle to get the ball where it needs to go. Students will continue to develop cooperation skills when working with others. Students will be assessed on kicking a ball towards a target, overarm throwing and cooperation with their peers.

Music

Students will be making and responding to music by exploring the ways that music can evoke stories, including soundscapes and sound stories, program music and lyric stories.

Maths

Year 2 - Students will be:

- dividing shapes and collections into halves, quarters and eighths
- counting to and from 1 000, represent three-digit numbers
- comparing and ordering objects, measure length, area and capacity using informal units



Design & Tech

Year 2 - Students will be exploring how plants and animals are grown for food, clothing and shelter and how food is selected and prepared for healthy eating and design solutions for a farm to enable successful food and fibre production.
