

Year 4 Curriculum Overview Term 3 2023



English- Exploring a Quest Novel- 'Rowan of Rin'

Students will read and analyse a quest novel. Throughout the unit, students are monitored as they post comments and respond to others' comments in a discussion board to demonstrate understanding of the quest novel. Students will also write a short response explaining how the author represents the main character in an important event in the quest novel.

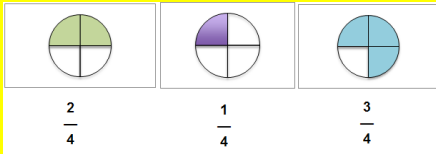


HASS- 'Using places sustainably'

Students will describe the characteristics of places, including the types of natural vegetation and native animals. They will examine the interconnections between people and environment and the importance of environments to animals and people.

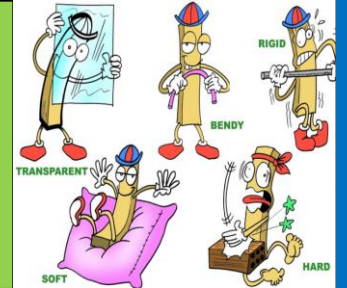
Mathematics

Students will cover various concepts and build on their existing knowledge of: Money, Symmetry, Place Value, Fractions, Decimals and Measurement.



Science- 'Material use'

Students will investigate physical properties of materials and consider how these properties influence the selection of materials for particular purposes. Students will consider how science involves making predictions and how science knowledge helps people to understand the effect of their actions.



Digital Technology- 'What's your waste footprint?'

Students will explore and manipulate different types of data and transform data into information. They will create a digital solution that presents data as meaningful information to address a school or community issue (such as how lunch waste can be reduced).

HPE

Students will refine large ball skills in a variety of modified games. They will participate in and investigate physical activities from other cultures as well as discuss fairness, inclusivity and the effectiveness of rules.



Music- 'Let's celebrate, let's remember'

Students make music and respond to music, exploring the songs used in celebrations and commemorations from a range of cultures including music for special occasions around the world.

LOTE- 'A package from France,' 'Sending greetings to France.'

This term students will learn about things that France is known for such as the Eiffel Tower. They will learn how to ask and say what things are called and learn the language of giving and receiving gifts. Students will learn how to describe things in French and express opinions.
