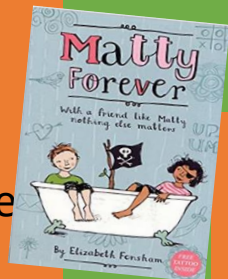


3P & 3C – Term 1

English

Students will listen to, view and read a novel to explore the authors' use of descriptive language in the construction of characters. They will use comprehension strategies to build literal and inferred meaning of the text. Students write a short imaginative narrative based on a familiar theme.



HPE

This term in HPE students will develop coordination, strength and balance through gymnastics. They will perform continuous movement sequences that incorporate the elements of movement; body awareness, effort (flow) and space awareness.

Science

Students will group living things based upon observable features and distinguish them from non-living things.



Technologies

Students will investigate how forces and the properties of materials affect the behaviour of a product or system, make a pinball machine, and design a games environment in which it can be used.

The Arts

Students will use relationships, tension, time, place and narrative structure when improvising and performing devised and scripted drama. They collaborate to plan, make and perform drama that communicates ideas.

Maths

In this unit students will apply a variety of mathematical concepts in real life and purely mathematical situations:

HASS

Students will identify individuals and past events that have significance in the present. They will identify and describe aspects of their community that have changed and remained the same over time. Students will examine how and why people participate in and contribute to their communities.
