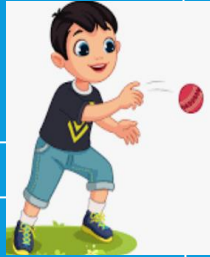


Year 3 Term 3 Overview

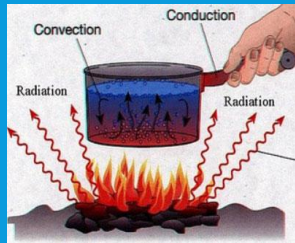
English

This term students will study a range of literary texts from different cultures. They will comprehend the texts and explore the text structure, language choices and visual features used to suit context, purpose and audience. Students will create a multimodal imaginative text.



Science

Students will investigate how heat energy is produced and the behaviour of heat when it transfers from one object or area to another.

In this unit students will investigate how technology has changed over time. They will explore the inquiry question: How and why are places similar or different?
