# Science Watch it Grow

Students will be exploring the growth of a range of living things and exploring the life cycle process. Through hands-on activities and investigations students will be comparing the growth of living things.

#### Drama

Drama stories from the past: students make and respond to drama by exploring photographs and stories of family and friends.

#### Maths

Students will draw two-dimensional shapes and recognise the features of three-dimensional objects. Students will also explain the effects of one-step transformations. They will describe outcomes for everyday events, collect, organise, represent and make sense of collected data, and make simple inferences.

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### HASS

Students investigate how technology has resulted in changes to travel, communication, leisure time, school, home life and toys. They learn how to use timelines, pose questions, analyse photographs and compare past and present. They identify how areas of life, such as rules of the present day, have been impacted by technology.

## Design and Technologies

Students will explore the following inquiry question: What will I need to make my puppet move?
Students will investigate materials, technologies for shaping and joining, and how designs meet people's needs. They will then produce a puppet that meets the design brief.

# English

Students will explore plot and characterisation in stories. Students will write an imaginative event to add to a familiar narrative and support the event with appropriate images that match the text.

#### Health

During Health in term 4, students will investigate a range of health messages focussed on healthy eating, getting moving (exercise) and taking care of their body (sun protection, keeping clean, brushing teeth etc.) and recognise their responsibility for making these choices. Students will be assessed on their understanding of how healthy eating, getting moving and taking care of their bodies keeps them healthy. Semester 2's HPE grade is a combination of the Physical Education grade from term 3 and the Health grade from term 4.
