

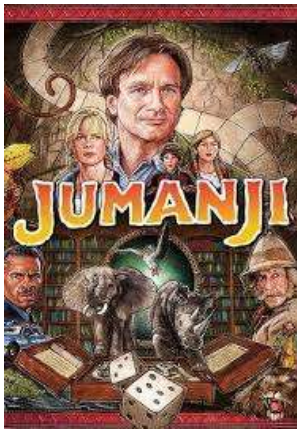
2024 Term 4 Overview

English: 'Comparing texts'

This term, students will listen to, read, and view films and novels. They will demonstrate understanding of the depiction of characters, setting and events in a chosen film. Students will create a written comparison of the picture book and the film, 'Jumanji.'



Mathematics:

Students will apply a variety of mathematical concepts in real-life, life-like, and purely mathematical situations.

Concepts include Number, Place Value, Fractions, Chance and Data.

SCIENCE: 'Show physics'

In this unit, students will investigate the properties of light and the formation of shadows.

They will investigate reflection angles, how refraction affects our perceptions of an object's location, how filters absorb light and affect how we perceive the colour of objects, and the relationship between light source distance and shadow height.
