English

In this unit, students will:

- •Create an informative text (written and with images) about a chosen animal
- •Plan and organise ideas using headings, clear sentences, relevant pictures and topic-specific vocabulary.
- •Use **features of a report**, such as: titles, noun and verb groups, possessive pronouns and correct punctuation.

Students will also:

- •Read and understand informative texts,
- •Compare how the same topic is presented in a narrative (story) format.
- Practise comprehension skills, answer questions, and read aloud to their teacher.

Maths

Students will:

- •Work with numbers up to 999 by breaking them into parts, regrouping, and renaming to help with addition and subtraction.
- •Solve everyday problems with money using these number skills.
- •Tell time to the hour, half hour, and quarter hour on an analogue clock.
- •Use a calendar to count the number of days between events.

Science

For biological sciences, students learn how plants and animals grow and change over time.

They will:

- •Explore and compare the life stages of different living things.
- •Investigate the growth of a class plant and animal.
- •Ask questions, make predictions, sort and compare information, and share their ideas in simple ways.

PE

Taught by Mrs Marks

During PE in term 2, students will develop the object-control skills of catching and throwing through active participation in activities, games and movement challenges. They will also apply rules and fair play practices. Students will discuss benefits of physical activity. Students will also develop their fitness through running in preparation for the cross country. Students will be assessed on their coordination and movement patterns when chest passing and catching and their interaction with others during physical tasks.

Technologies
