Students will engage with texts that contain straightforward sequences of events and everyday happenings. They will develop knowledge and skills to retell real experiences, and imaginative events experienced by the characters. They will develop an awareness of vocabulary used in familiar contexts and explore language for expressing and developing ideas when retelling experiences or events in stories.

Maths

Students will continue to develop their understanding of mathematical applications by representing and solving everyday problems that involve quantifying, equal sharing, adding to and taking away from collections to at least 10. They will name, create and compare shapes and explore mass, capacity, length of objects and duration. Students will build confidence and autonomy in being able to make and justify mathematical decisions.

Exploring and Learning

HASS: Students will explore the inquiry question: What are places and what makes them special?

Science: Students use their senses to explore and observe the weather in their local environment and learn that we can record our observations using symbols.

Design Technologies: Students will explore how plants and animals are grown for food, clothing and shelter, and how food is selected and prepared for healthy eating.

PE: Students will use personal and social skills to learn dribbling skills and how to manipulate balls with equipment.
