

Prep C and Prep J

Term 4 Learning Overview

English:

This term students are exploring characters and events in stories. They will create a short written text to retell a familiar story. Students will work on developing proficiency as readers and gain meaning from the texts they read.

Mathematics:

This term students will explore situations, using a variety of materials to represent and partition everyday problems. They will look for and make connections between number names, numerals and quantities and compare quantities to at least 20. Students will learn to recognise repetition in pattern sequences and apply this to creatively build repeating patterns.

HASS:

Students will continue to explore the following inquiry question: What are places and what makes them special?

Design and Technologies:

Students will explore how plants and animals are grown for food, clothing and shelter, and how food is selected and prepared for healthy eating.

Science:

Students will use their senses to observe and explore the properties and movement of objects. They will engage in hands-on investigations and respond to questions about the factors that influence movement.

Music:

Students will continue to explore rhymes and songs as stimulus for music making and responding.

HPE:

In health, students identify actions to keep them safe with medicines and poisons, and in situations involving water and fire.
Students will also complete swimming lessons as part of their unit.

Homework:

Prep C: Homework will be distributed on Monday and will be due back on Friday.
Prep J: Homework will be distributed on Tuesday and will be due back on Monday.
Both classes will have a focus on reading and comprehension this term.
