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Installing and Managing Apps at home:

Parents are responsible for the purchase of all required school apps, as well as ensuring the device and apps are regularly updated. Once the apps are purchased, they are the property of the purchaser (parent/student).

Student iPads need to have Intune installed to ensure full functionality while at school. Intune is a secure mobile management system that allows students to use school Wi-Fi, emails, learning applications and websites on personal devices. Please have your student MIS ID, email address, and password in order to successfully complete the installation. Family Sharing makes it easy for up to six family members to share iTunes, iBooks and App Store purchases and iCloud storage plan. Your family can also share a photo album, calendar, reminders and even help locate each other's missing devices. Please be aware of enabling photo sharing across devices as this can impact storage space. To participate in Family Sharing, all family members must have their own Apple ID. Children under 13 cannot create an Apple ID on their own. However, as a parent or legal guardian, the family organiser can provide verified parental consent for a child to have their own Apple ID, then create it on the child's behalf. If your child already has an Apple ID, you can update their email address, date of birth, security questions and more. When you create an Apple ID for a child, it will be added to your family group automatically. \*All Queensland state school students can download a free copy of the latest Microsoft Office suite to their personal home computer or iPad.

To download the Office suite on a personal PC or Mac, head to portal.office.com and sign in using student email and password. Click the 'Install Office' button on the right-hand side of the page and follow the prompts. To download on an iPad, download each Office app from the Apple app store, and then sign into one of the installed Office apps using student email and password to activate. Student email address is EQ username@eq.edu.au (E.g. student1@eq.edu.au).
