This funding will be used to

- Increase the total number of students achieving a 'C' or higher in English from 93.2% to greater than 98%.
- Increase the total number of students achieving a 'C' or higher in Mathematics from 92.8% to greater than 98%.
- Increase the number of students achieving an 'A' in English from 28.8% to greater than 32%.
- Increase the number of students achieving an 'A' in Mathematics from 30.3% to greater than 35%.

Our initiatives include

- Release teachers to engage in the collaborative assessment of student work within the framework of the school moderation cycle, effectively informing the next steps in teaching and learning. (Sharratt 2019; Dufour,1998)
- Provide opportunities for coaching and mentoring to develop a consistent understanding and application of differentiation strategies using WOW and other school based strategies. (Tomlinson, 2010;Sharratt and Fullan, 2012)
- Research driven professional learning and engagement to develop a whole school approach to effective feedback linked to success criteria and learning intentions. (Hattie and Clark, 2019;Sharratt 2019)
- Continued implementation of the Response to Intervention and Instruction Program with targeted and extensive teacher-aide support in classrooms (Buffum, 2011; Fisher and Frey, 2010; Sharratt 2012)
- Proving access to Tier 3 extension for students identified as A and B Students. (Buffum, 2011; Fisher and Frey, 2010)
- Intensive in-classroom student support with teacher aides supporting pedagogical practice in writing and reading. (Archer and Hughes, 2011; Marzano, 2011; Cameron 2013)

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Release classroom teachers to collaborate in CASW sessions to deepen teacher understanding of data literacy, moderation and the pedagogies to provide differentiated teaching and learning programs.
