Form 2.0 - Enrolment Agreement

This enrolment agreement sets out the responsibilities of the student, parents or carers and the school staff about the education of students enrolled at Dayboro State School.

We welcome the opportunity to share responsibility for your child's learning. We believe these responsibilities include:

Our STUDENTS upholding Dayboro's 5 VALUES – Be Respectful, Be Responsible, Be Proud, Be Tolerant and Be Positive, and therefore:

- attending school on every school day for the educational program in which they are enrolled, on time, ready to learn and take part in school activities
- acting at all times with respect and showing tolerance towards other students and staff
- working hard and comply with requests or directions from the teacher and principal
- abiding by school rules as outlined in the school's Responsible Behaviour Plan for Students
- meeting homework requirements and wearing the school uniform with pride
- respecting the school property and environment.

Our PARENTS upholding Dayboro's 5 VALUES – Be Respectful, Be Responsible, Be Proud, Be Tolerant and Be Positive, and therefore:

- ensuring your child attends school on every school day for the educational program in which they are enrolled
- attending open meetings for parents
- letting the school know if there are any problems that may affect your child's ability to learn
- ensuring your child completes homework regularly in keeping with the school's homework policy
- informing the school of student absences and reasons for absences in a timely manner
- treating school staff with respect
- supporting the authority of school staff thereby supporting their efforts to educate your child and assisting your child to achieve maturity, self-discipline and self-control
- not allowing your child to bring dangerous or inappropriate items to school
- abiding by school's instructions regarding access to school grounds before, during and after school hours
- advising the Principal if your student is in the care of the State
- keeping the school informed of any changes to student's details, such as student's home address and phone number.
